Sitka Herringbone Rib Neckwarmer

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MATERIALS: 1 Skein Cascade Yarn's Sitka: 80% wool, 20% Kid Mohair (131 yds)

Size 9 needles Yarn needle 3 buttons

MEASUREMENTS: 24" x 6 ½" approx..

GAUGE: 4 st = 1'', 11 rows = 2''

ABBREVIATIONS: st = stitch tog = together tbl = through back loop

RT = K 2 tog leaving sts on left needle and knit the first st again

rep = repeat

Seed Stitch

Row 1: * K1, P1* rep bet *'s across

Row 2: Knit on the purl sts and purl on the knit sts as they face you.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for pattern.

SCARF

Cast on 35 sts. Work in seed stitch for 4 rows.

Pattern Stitch

Row 1: K1tbl, (P1, K1) 3 times, P1, *(RT) 3 times, (P1, K1) 3 times, P1; rep from * once, P1, K1tbl.

Row 2: K1tbl, (K1, P1) 3 times, K1, *P6, (K1, P1) 3 times, K1; rep from * once, K1tbl.

Row 3: K1tbl, (P1, K1) 3 times, P1, *K1, (RT) 2 times, K1, (P1, K1) 3 times, P1; rep from * once, K1tbl.

Row 4: As row 2.

Repeat these 4 rows for pattern.

Work 12 rows of pattern, then make button hole (using next row 1) as follows:

K1tbl, (P1, K1) 3 times, P1, (RT) 3 times, (P1, K1) 3 times, P1, (RT) 3 times, YO, K2tog, (P1, K1) 2 times, P1, K1tbl.

Make 2 more button holes as above on 21st row and 29th row.

Work until scarf measures 23" and work 4 rows in seed stitch.

Bind off. Weave in loose ends.

Try scarf on for comfortable placement of buttons, mark, and sew on.
