Eco Cloud Mock Cable Watch Cap Designed by Tanis Gray

Materials:

- 1 Hank Cascade Yarns *Eco Cloud* (3.5oz/100g ea approx. 164yds/150m, 70% undyed merino wool, 30% undyed baby alpaca) #1804
- Size 9 16" Circular Knitting Needles
- Size 9 DPNs
- Tapestry Needle

Gauge:

• 16 sts and 23 rows over 4" in Stockinette

Approximate Finished Size:

• One Size Fits All Adult 22" Circumference

Abbreviations:

Kfb: knit through the front and back

Mock Rib:

- Row 1: *k1, p1* to end of row
- Row 2: knit

Instructions:

- With circular needles, cable cast on 80 sts, join into round
- Work mock rib for 3.75"
- Next Row: *k9, kfb* to end of row 88 sts
- Knit until piece measures 8" from CO edge
- Next Row: k2tog to end of row 44 sts
- Next Row: knit
- Next Row: k2tog to end of row 22 sts
- Next Row: knit
- Next Row: k2tog to end of row 11 sts
- Next Row: knit
- Next Row: k2tog to last st, k1 6 sts
- Break yarn, leaving 12" tail, weave through remaining sts, secure on WS
- Weave in all loose ends with tapestry needle
- Block
