# Cloud Just Enough Stole

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Materials: Cascade Yarn's Cloud: 70% Merino Wool, 30% Baby Alpaca: 3 skeins color 2110

Needles size #9 & 10 ½ circulars 29" or larger if desired

Yarn needle, markers

Finished Measurement: Width, approx. 48" (excluding ties), length approx. 14"

Gauge: 14 sts = 4" in seed stitch with 10 ½ needles

#### Seed Stitch:

Row 1: \*K1, P1\* rep between \*'s, end K1.

Row 2: Purl on the knit stitches and knit on the purl stitches as they face you.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for pattern.

Abbreviations: tbl = knit in the back loop K1-b = knit in back loop

#### **STOLE**

With larger needles, cast on 117 sts and work in seed st for 16 rows.

Change to size 9 needles.

Row 17: Knit.

Row 18 Purl.

Row 19: K7, K3tog, \*K17, K3tog\* rep between \*'s to last 7 sts, K7. (105 sts)

Row 20: Purl.

Change to size 10 ½ needles.

Rows 21 – 36 work in seed stitch (16 rows)

Change to size 9 needles.

Row 37: Knit.

Row 38: Purl.

Row 39: K6, K3tog, \*K15, K3tog\* rep between \*'s to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 40: Purl.

Change to size 10 ½ needles.

Rows 41-54 work in seed stitch. (14 rows)

Change to size 9 needles.

Row 55: Knit.

Row 56: Purl.

Row 57: K5, K3 tog, \*K13, K3tog \* rep between \*'s to last 5 sts, K5. (81 sts)

Row 58: Purl.

Change to size 10 ½ needles.

Rows 59 – 72 work in seed stitch. (14 rows)

Change to size 9 needles.

Row 73: Knit.

Row 74: Purl.

Row 75: K4, K3tog, \*K11, K3tog \* rep between \*'s to last 4 sts, K4. (69 sts)

Row 76: Purl.

Change to size 10 ½ needles.

Rows 77 – 88 work in seed stitch. (12 rows)

Change to size 9 needles and work in K1, P1 ribbing for 3 rows, bind off loosely.

#### **Front Section & Ties**

With right side of work facing using size 9 needles, pick up and knit 53 sts evenly alongside edge of stole.

Row 1 and every alt. row: Knit to end.

Row 2: K24, K2tog, K1, K2tog tbl, K24.

Row 4: K23, K2tog, K1, K2tog tbl, K23.

Row 6: K22, K2tog, K1, K2tog tbl, K22.

Continue to decrease in this way until 9 sts remain ending with a knit row,.

Place markers at each end of last row.

### <u>Tie</u> (working with last 9 sts)

Row 1: K1, \*P1, K1; rep from \* to end.

Row 2: P1, \*K1-b, P1; rep from \* to end.

Row 3: K1, (Pl, K1-b; rep from \* to last 2 sts, P1, K1.

Repeat last 2 rows until ties measure 10".

Bind off loosely in rib.

Repeat for other side.

Weave in all ends and steam slightly if necessary.
