Cascade 128 Chunky Diamond Chullos

128 CHUNKY DIAMOND CHULLO

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Colorful pattern bands wrap around this hat with integrated earflaps. The flaps are completed first, then stitches are cast on for the body of the hat which is worked circular. Single crochet finishes the edge. Multi-colored braids adorn the top and are used as ties.

Skill Level

Intermediate

Yarn Weight

#5 bulky

Size

Adult; fits most

Finished measurement

Circumference: 20"

Materials

Cascade 128 Chunky (100% Peruvian Highland wool) 100g/128 yds per skein: 2 skeins #9463B Gold (MC), 1 skein **each** #9553 IceBlue and #9465B Burnt Orange

Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular and 1 set double-pointed needles (dpn)

Stitch markers

Size G/6 (4.25mm) crochet hook

Gauge

16 sts x 22 rnds = 4" in color pat

To save time and ensure proper fit, take time to check gauge.

Designer Note

To avoid puckering, carry colors not in use loosely across back of work.

Earflaps (Make 2 alike)

With MC, cast on 5 sts. Purl 1 row.

Inc Row: K2, knit in row below st on RH needle, knit to last 2 sts, knit in row below st on LH needle.

Row 2: Purl. Rep last 2 rows 5 times more – 17 sts.

Work even in St st for 4 rows.

Cut yarn and place sts on dpn.

Hat

With MC, cast on 10 sts, knit across 1 earflap, cast on 26 sts, knit across second flap, cast on 10 sts – 80 sts. Join without twisting, placing marker between first and last st for center back.

Knit 6 rnds. Work 20 rnds of chart, work even in MC only until hat measures 7½" above cast-on sts.

Shape top

Place a marker after every 10th st.

Dec rnd: [Knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog] 8 times – 8 sts decreased.

Knit 1 rnd even.

Rep last 2 rnds until 8 sts remain, changing to dpn when necessary.

Cut yarn, leaving an 8" end. Draw through rem sts twice.

Edging

Beg at center back, work 1 rnd sc around entire lower edge, making sure to keep work flat.

Ties

Cut 2 18-inch strands of each color. Holding all strands tog, pull them through cast-on edge of earflap. Adjust ends evenly. Braid, having 4 strands of each color in each section (see pictures). Tie end in an overhand knot to secure.

Tassels

Cut strands of yarn, each 6-8" long in your choice of colors. Attach 3 strands to top of hat, and braid as for ties, having 2 strands in each group. Make as many braided tassels as you wish.
