Ribbed Hat



Magnum Ribbed Hat

Designed by Shannon Dunbabin

Materials: 1 skein Cascade Yarns Magnum (100% Peruvian Highland Wool – 123 yard per 250 g)
– shown in color 4009

1 set US 15 Double Point Needles (and 16” Circular Needles – optional for body of hat)

Abbreviations: DPN – Double Point Needles

K – Knit

P – Purl

K2Tog – Knit 2 Together

K2P1 – Knit 2 Purl 1

Cast on 42 stitches (to either DPNs or Circular needles). Join work in the round being careful not to twist.

If using circular needles, place stitch marker at beginning of round.

*K2, P1, repeat from * (13 repeats per round). Continue for 10” (or desired length).

Start decreasing 6 stitches per row as follows:

Row 1: *K5, K2Tog, repeat from *

Row 2: *K4, K2Tog, repeat from *

Row 3: *K3, K2Tog, repeat from *

Row 4: *K2, K2Tog, repeat from *

Row 5: *K1, K2Tog, repeat from *

Row 6: *K2Tog, repeat from *

Thread yarn (after cutting) through the remaining 6 stitches and pull tight.
