## Cabled Chemo Cap

Materials: Cascade Yarn's Fixation: 1 skein 100yds of #9251  
Size #7 circular needle 16" and double pointed needles  
Cable needle  
Stitch marker  
Yarn needle

Gauge: 4 pattern repeats (32 sts) approx 4 ½" Hat is stretchy.

C2 = Skip next st, K into 2<sup>nd</sup> st and leave on needle, K into skipped st and slip both off needle.

C4B = Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in back of work, K next 2 sts, K sts from cable needle.

### Pattern Stitch

Row 1: \*K4, P1, C2, P1\* repeat between \*'s around.

Row 2: \*K4, P1, K2, P1\* repeat between \*'s around.

Row 3: \*C4B, P1, C2, P1\* repeat between \*'s around.

Row 4: as row 2.

Repeat 4 rows for pattern.

### HAT

Cast on 90 sts and join being careful not to twist stitches. Work in K1, P1 ribbing for 1" increasing to 104 on the last row..

Begin pattern stitch and work until hat is 7" from beginning.

### Shape Cap

Row 1: \*K6, K2tog\* repeat around.

Row 2 and following even rows: Knit

Row 3: \*K5, K2tog\* repeat around.

Row 5: \*K4, K2tog\* repeat around.

Row 7: \*K3, K2tog\* repeat around.

Row 9: \*K2, K2tog\* repeat around.

Row 11: K1, K2tog\* repeat around.

Row 13: \*K2tog\* repeat around.

Row 15: repeat row 13 ending K1.

Break yarn leaving long end to secure and using a yarn needle run end through remaining stitches and weave in ends.
