220 Superwash® Paints Chocolate Mint Tam

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This lovely yarn works up into a rich swirl of color. The pattern is easily constructed with a narrow rib, an increase round, even work to make the base, and finally decrease rounds narrow to the center.

Skill Level: Intermediate

Size: Adult Large

Finished Diameter: 12"

Materials:

MC: 1 skein 220 Superwash® Paints (100% Superwash Wool 100g. 220 yards), color 9876,

Two 16 " size US #7 circular needles or one set of US# 7 dbl points

Blunt sewing needle

6 stitch markers

Gauge

10 sts and 14 rnds = 2" in stocking stitch

Brim

Cast on 92 sts. Remove the slip knot and join in a circle taking care not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-5: *K1,P1, repeat *to the end of the rnds

Increase Rnd: *K2, M1, repeat * to the end of the rnd, 138 sts

Work even for 4" - total 5"

Decrease rnds: Set up *K23, pm, repeat * to end of the rnd, 6 sections

Rnd 1: Knit to 2 sts before m, k2tog, slip marker: repeat * to end of rnd, 132 sts

Rnd 2: Knit even

Repeat decrease rounds 1 and 2 until there are 10 sts between markers.

Repeat Decrease Rnd 1 until 6 sts remain.

Cut a 6" length of yarn

With a blunt sewing needle, thread the yarn through the loops and cinch.

Weave the yarn end to the inside. Block the tam on a dinner plate.
