Snow on the Mountain Hat and Mittens

Materials

Cascade Cash Vero, 55% Merino Extra Fine Wool, 33% Microfiber Acrylic, 12% Cashmere. 98 yards, 50g
2 each of 024 [a], 028 [c]
1 each of 039 [b], 010 [d], 008 [e], 034 [f], 001[g]
Size 7, 16 inch circular needle
Set of size 7 double point needles (dpn)
Set of size 5 double point needles
Large crochet hook, I or J
Tapestry needle
Stitch holder
Stitch marker

Gauge

5 stitches and 6 rows per inch in stockinette stitch

Pattern Notes.

All slip stitches (sl) are slipped as if to purl. Make one (m1) increases are worked by lifting the bar between 2 stitches with the left hand needle from front to back then knitting in to the back of the raised bar.

Hat

Ear Flaps (make 2)

With a, cast on 7 stitches and knit 2 rows

Row 3 (rs): k3, m1, k1, m1, k3. 9 stitches

Row 4: k3, p3, k3.

Row 5: k3, m1, k3, m1, k3. 11 stitches

Row 6: k3, p5, k3.

Row 7: with b, leaving a attached, k3, m1, (sl1[a], k1[b]) to last 4, sl1[a], m1, k3. 13 stitches

Row 8: k3, (p1[b], sl1[a]) to last 4, p1, k3.

Row 9: with a, k3 m1, (sl1[b], k1[a]) to last 4, sl1[b], m1, k3. 15 stitches

Row 10: k3, (p1[a], sl1[b]), to last 4, p1, k3.

Rows 11-16: repeat rows 7-10 once, then rows 7-8 once. 21 stitches

Break a.

Row 17: With b, k3, m1, k to last 3, m1, k3. 23 stitches

Row 18: k3, p to last 3, k3.

Row 19-22: Repeat rows 17-18 twice. 27 stitches

Row 23: With c, leaving b attached, k3, (k1[c], sl1[b]) to last 4, k4.

Row 24, k3, (p1[c], sl1[b]), to last 4, p1, k3.

Row 25, with b, k3, (sl1[c], k1[b]), to last 4, sl1[c], k3.

Row 26: k3, (sl1[c], p1[b]) to last 4, sl1[c], k3.
Rows 27-30: repeat rows 23-26 once, then rows 23-24 once
Break B
Row 31: with C, k
Row 32 k3, p to last 3, k3
Rows 33-34: repeat rows 31-32 once.

Place first earflap on a stitch holder, and work 2nd earflap as first

Body of Hat

With the earflap on the needle, k 27, turn and cable cast on 36 for front, turn and k 27 across 2nd earflap, turn and cable cast on 30 for back. Pm for beginning of the round. 120 stitches. Work 2 rounds in a k1 p1 rib on front and back and k on earflaps.

Join D. Work 2 rounds k1[d], sl1[c], then 2 rounds sl1[d], k1[c]. Repeat these 4 rounds once, then the first 2 rounds once. Break c and k 6 rounds[d].

Join e. Work 2 rounds k1[e], sl1[d], then 2 rounds sl1[e], k1[d]. Repeat these 4 rounds once, then the first 2 rounds once. Break d and k 6 rounds[e].

Join f. Work 2 rounds k1[f], sl1[e], then 2 rounds sl1[f], k1[e]. Repeat these 4 rounds once, then the first 2 rounds once. Break e and k 6 rounds[f].

Join g. Work 2 rounds k1[g], sl1[f], then 2 rounds sl1[e], k1[d]. Repeat these 4 rounds once, then the first 2 rounds once. Break f.

Crown

Begin using dpn when needed.

Round 1: with g, *k10, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round

Round 2: k all stitches.

Round 3: *k9, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 4: *k8, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 5: *k7, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 6: *k6, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 7: *k5, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 8: *k4, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 9: *k3, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 10: *k2, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 11: *k1, k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 12: *k2tog, repeat from * to end of round.

Break g. With tapestry needle, run the yarn through the remaining 10 stitches. Pull tight and secure.

Tassels

With a, cut 24 18-inch lengths of yarn. With 12 lengths of yarn laying parallel, fold in half so that all the loose ends are together. With a large crochet hook pull the folded end through the knitting at the bottom of one earflap from front to back. Pull loose ends through the loop. Braid to end. Tie braid at the bottom with an overhand knot to secure. Trim ends if desired. Repeat for other earflap.

Mittens

Cuff

With size 5 dpn and a, co 40, place marker at beginning of round and work in k2 p2 rib for 6 rounds. Join b, k2[b], p2[a]. Work 6 rounds. Break a.

With size 7 dpns and b, k 6 rounds.

Join c. Work 2 rounds sl1[b], k1[c], then 2 rounds k1[b], sl1[c]. Repeat these 4 rounds once, then the first 2 rounds once. Break b.

Thumb increase [c]

k 1 round.

*k10, m1. Repeat from * to end of round. 44sts.

k1 round

*k11, m1. Repeat from * to end of round.

k1 round

*k12, m1. Repeat from * to end of round.

Join d. Work 2 rounds sl1[c], k1[d], then 2 rounds k1[c], sl1[d]. Repeat these 4 rounds once, then the first 2 rounds once. Break c.

k12, slip on holder. Work to end of rnd. Turn and cable cast on 4, turn join. 44 sts.
Work 5 rounds.

Join e. Work 2 rounds sl1[d], k1[e], then 2 rounds k1[d], sl1[e]. Repeat these 4 rounds once, then the first 2 rounds once. Break d. Work 6 rounds

Join f. Work 2 rounds sl1[e], k1[f], then 2 rounds k1[e], sl1[f]. Repeat these 4 rounds once, then the first 2 rounds once. Break e. Work 4 rounds. Next round, *k9, k2tog. Repeat from * to end round – 40 sts.

Join g. Work 2 rounds sl1[f], k1[g], the 2 rounds k1[f], sl1[g]. Repeat these 4 rounds once. Break f.

Hand decreases

*k8, k2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

*k7, k2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

*k6, k2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Continue working one less stitch prior to the decrease until 8 stitches remain. Join with Kitchner stitch. Work in ends with tapestry needle.

Thumb

Transfer the 12 stitches on the holder on to 2 dpns. With a 3rd dpn, pick up 6 stitches along cast on edge. Work in the round until thumb measures 2 inches or desired length.

*k3, k2tog. Repeat from * to end of round.

Continue working one less stitch prior to the decrease until 6 stitches remain. Break yarn. With tapestry needle run yarn through stitches. Pull tight and secure.
