# JEWEL PURSE

## Designed by Susie Bonell

Materials: Cascade Yarn's Jewel 100% Peruvian Highland Wool: 1 Skein color #9254
Needles size 9
Purse Handles (Model used Purse n-alize-it 6 4/5" x 4 ¼" wooden ovals)
1ea 1" button
Yarn needle
Sewing needle and thread to match yarn

Gauge: 3 ¾ sts = 1" in pattern

Purse Measurements: 11" wide at bottom, 8" high not including handles.

#### Fluted Rib Pattern Stitch

Row 1, 2 and 3: P1, \*K7, P1; rep from \*. Row 4: K2, \*P5, K3; rep from \* end P5, K2. Row 5: P3, \*K3, P5; rep from \*, end K3, P3. Row 6, 7, & 8: K4, \*P1, K7; rep from \*, end P1, K4. Row 9: Repeat row 5. Row 10: Repeat Row 4. Repeat rows 1-10 for pattern.

#### PURSE

Cast on 41 sts. NOTE: If you use a provisional cast on you will not have to pick up and knit stitches for the handle tab.

Work in Fluted Rib Pattern until pattern has been worked 9 times. (90 rows).

### Handle Tab

Next row: K1, \*K2tog, rep from \* across row. (21 sts)

Work in Stockinette stitch (knit one row, purl one row) beginning with a purl row for  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " or length needed to wrap around handle for sewing. (Thicker handles need longer tabs). Bind off. Cut yarn leaving long tail for sewing down tab.

Second Tab

If you used a regular cast on, with right side facing, pick up and knit 41 sts across row cast on row. Next row: P1, \*P2 tog across next row and finish as first tab. If you used a provisional cast on, release live stitches and proceed as for 1<sup>st</sup> tab.

Sew handle tabs over handles. Sew side seams up to 2" from handles.

Button Tab

Cast on 6 sts and work in garter stitch, (knit every row) for 5" or length from bottom of handle in back through handles to point where want the button to be. <u>Button hole:</u> K2, bind off 2, K remaining st.

<u>Button noie.</u> K2, bind on 2, K remaining st.

Next row: Cast on 2 sts over bound off sts.

Knit one row.

<u>Tab Point:</u>

Next row: SSK, K2, K2tog. Knit one row. Next row: SSK, K2tog Next row: K2tog. Cut yarn and weave in end, reinforcing buttonhole as necessary.

Sew button tab to back below handle where button tab begins. Sew button on front.
