# Cascade 220<sup>®</sup> Sport Dotted Diamond Mitts

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These classically styled mittens feature a slip-stitch pattern that uses only one color in each row. The cuffs are worked in  $1 \times 1$  twisted ribbing, and there are afterthought thumbs. Double-pointed needles are used throughout.

## Yarn Weight

#2 fine

#### Size

Adult S/M (L/XL)

#### **Finished Measurements**

Hand circumference: 8 (9)"

Length: 9 (10)"

#### Materials

Cascade 220® Sport (100% Peruvian Highland wool) 50g/164 yds per hank: 1 hank **each** #8686 Dk Brown (MC) and #2414 Rust (CC)

Size 4 (3.5mm) set of 4 double-pointed needles or size needed to obtain gauge

½ yd CC waste yarn, cut in 2 pieces

#### Gauge

20 sts x 32 rnds = 4'' in color pat

To save time and ensure proper fit, take time to check gauge.

## Stitch Glossary

**Tbl:** Through back loop.

Wyif: With yarn in front.

Wyib: With yarn in back.

#### 1x1 Twisted Rib

**All rnds:** \*K1-tbl, p1; rep from \* around.

Flecked Tweed (multiple of 4 sts)

**Rnd 1:** With CC, \*k3, sl 1 wyif; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 2:** With CC, \*k3, sl 1 wyib; rep from \* around.

Rnd 3: With MC, \*k1, sl 1 wyif, k2; rep from \* around.

Rnd 4: With MC, \*k1, sl 1 wyib, k2; rep from \* around.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for pat.

#### **Designer Note**

Work sl sts loosely.

## Right Mitten

With MC, cast on 40 (44) sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles as follows:

Size S/M: 14 sts on needles #1 and #3, 12 sts on needle #2.

Size L/XL: 16 sts on needles #1 and #1, 12 sts pm needle #2.

Join without twisting.

Work even in 1x1 Twisted Rib for  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Change to Flecked Tweed pat and work even until mitten measures approx 5 (5½)" from beg, ending with Rnd 3 of pat.

## Mark for thumb opening

**Next rnd:** Work 4 sts in established pat, k8 (10) with CC waste yarn, sl 8 (10) sts just worked back to LH ndl, k8 (10) MC, work in established pat to end of rnd. Work even in est pat until mitten measures approx 7½ (8½)" from beg, ending with Rnd 4 of pat.

#### Shape top

SI 6 sts from ndl #2 to ndl #1 and remaining 6 sts of ndl #2 to ndl #3. Work with 3 ndls only from this point.

**Dec rnd:** Working in established color sequence \*ssk, work to last 2 sts of ndl #1, k2tog; rep from \* on ndl #2.

**Next rnd:** Work even in established pat.

Rep last 2 rnds until 10 sts remain on each ndl – 20 sts. Cut yarn and weave top.

# Thumb

Remove waste yarn and place resulting sts on ndls as follows:

8 (10) sts nearest top of mitten on ndl #1, and 4 (5) sts each on ndls #2 and #3 along bottom of opening. Pick up 1 st at each end of opening – 18 (22) sts. Join yarns and work next pat rnd, dec 1 st at each end of opening – 16 (20) sts. Work even until thumb measures approx 2  $(2\frac{1}{2})$ ", ending with Rnd 4 of pat.

# Shape tip

Dec rnd: With CC, k2tog around – 4 (5) sts.

Cut yarn and draw through remaining sts.

# **Left Mitten**

Work as for right mitten to thumb opening.

**Next rnd:** Work to last 12 (14) sts of rnd. Work thumb opening over next 8 (10) sts as for right mitten. Work as for right mitten to top shaping.

SI 6 sts from ndl #2 to ndl #1, and remaining 6 sts from ndl #2 to ndl #3.

Shape top and thumb as for right mitten.
