Wheel of Hearts Beanie

Cascade 220 Fingering Weight Yarn 100% Peruvian Highland Wool (50 gr/ 1.75 oz. 273 yards/250 m)

These cute patterns are knit stranded with the dark yarns carried under or in the left hand. *Some store models have been knit with a K2P2 ribbing rather than K3,P1. Knitters choice!*

Beanie

Size: Women's Med/Lg 18" circumference

Materials: 1 skein each:

Burgundy: 2401

Orange: 7825

Dark Green: 9429

Yellow: 7827

Light Green: 8903

Pink: 9478

Needle: One 16" US #3 circular or set of 4 dbl pts

7 stitch markers

Blunt sewing needle

Gauge: 18 sts/2" in stranded pattern

Note: Double decrease: Slip 2 Sts, K1, Pass Slipped Sts Over

Cuff

With 2 burgundy strands held tog, cast on 148 sts

Join and work in the round and continue with 2 mc strands held tog:

Rnds 1-12: Ribbing: *K3, P1, rep from * around

Rnd 13: Increase Rnd: K3, *M1, K3, rep from * around – 196 sts

Rnd 14: Knit even with 1 burgundy strand, pm, k28, rep from * around to make a total of 7 sections of 28 sts each

Cut one burgundy strand and add orange strand

Rnds 15 – 20: Beanie Chart

Change the burgundy strand to dark green and the orange strand to yellow.

Rnds 21 - 27: Beanie Chart

Change the yellow strand to light green.

Rnds 28 – 33: Beanie Chart

Repeat Rnds 15-27 in reverse order per chart

Rnd 47: With single burgundy strand, *M1, K28, sl m, rep * around, for 7 sections of 29 sts – 203 sts

Rnd 48: Knit even with 1 burgundy strand

Add pink strand:

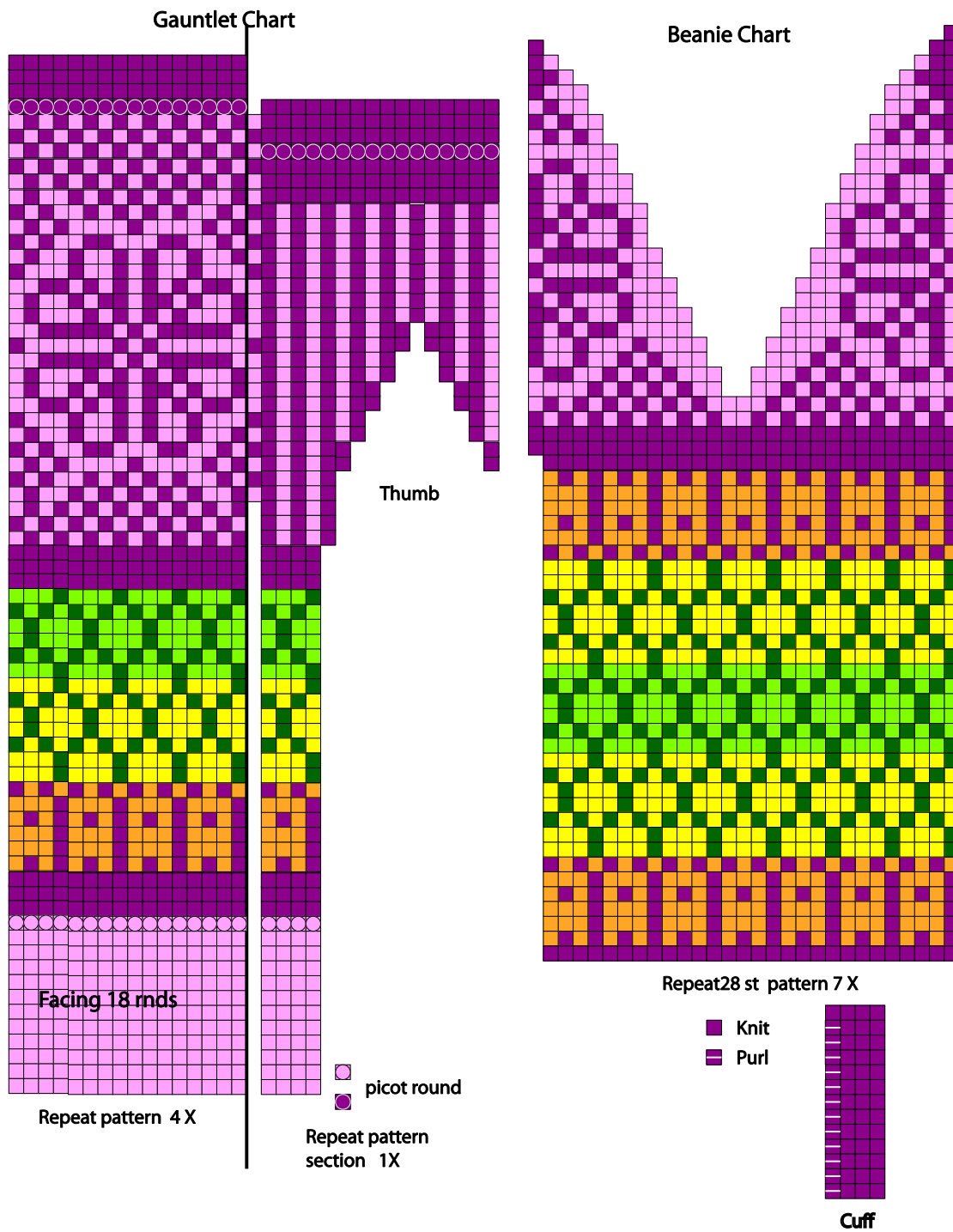
Complete **Wheel of Hearts** Section of chart

When there are 14 Sts remaining, K2 tog with burgundy around.

Cut strand and thread through the loops. Cinch, move strand to the inside.

Weave in ends.

Wheel of Hearts



Gauntlets/Fingerless Mitts

Materials: 1 skein each:

Burgundy: 2401

Orange: 7825

Dark Green: 9429

Yellow: 7827

Light Green: 8903

Pink: 9478

Needles: Two 16" US #3 circulars and/or set of 4 dbl pts

Three stitch markers

Blunt sewing needle

Gauge: 18 sts/2" in stranded pattern

Cuff Facing: Beg Gauntlet Chart

With single strand pink, cast on 68 sts, join and work in the round

Rnds 1-18: Knit

Rnd 19: Picot rnd: *K2tog, YO, rep * to end

Switch to burgundy

Rnds 20 – 22: Knit

Add orange strand

Rnds 23 - 28: Gauntlet Chart

Switch burgundy to dark green and orange to yellow

Rnds 29 – 34: Gauntlet chart

Switch yellow to light green

Rnds 35 – 41: Gauntlet Chart

Cut green strand 6"

Rnds 42 – 44: With single strand burgundy, knit

Add pink strand

Wheel of Hearts Chart Section

Rnd 1: M1 burgundy, K4 in stripe for thumb, cont 4 patt repeats around

Rnd 4: K 5 in stripe for thumb, M1 pink, complete rnd per chart

Rnd 6: Begin Thumb gusset increases** per the chart

Rnds 7 – 23: Chart

Rnd 24: Place 17 st of the thumb on waste yarn. Cast on 5 Sts alt strands in patt for the back of thumb.

Rnds 25 – 29: complete the wheel of hearts section

Rnd 30: Picot rnd: K2tog, YO, rep from * around

Next 3 rnds: knit around

Bind off loosely, cut strand 8"

Fold the facing to the inside at the picot rnd. It is helpful to steam block the facing at the turn.

Pin and overcast the hem with the blunt needle and yarn strand.

Thumb: Remove the 17 Sts from the waste yarn and place on 2 dbl pt needles

With 3rd dbl pt needle, use a burgundy strand pick up and knit 1 st at the corner, alternating pink and burgundy, pick up 5 sts from the back of the thumb and 1 st from the other corner. Work following the chart in the round to the first picked up St.

Rnd 1: K2tog, k 5, k2tog, K 17 Sts

Rnds 2 -3: Knit

Picot Rnd: *K2tog, YO, rep from * around

Rnds 5-7: Knit

Bind off loosely, cut strand 8"

Fold the facing to the inside at the picot rnd. It is helpful to steam block the facing at the turn.

Pin and overcast the hem with the blunt needle and yarn strand

Repeat for the second Gauntlet

**Increases may be M1 or right and left lifted increases
