Cash Vero DK Fingerless Gloves By Margaret Santino

Materials: Cascade Yarns Cash Vero DK 55% Merino Extra Fine wool, 33% Microfiber acrylic, 12% Cash-

mere: 1 skein #08 (mc), 1 skein #24 (cc)

Size 6 knitting needles

Stitch markers

Waste yarn or stitch holder

Yarn needle

Abbreviations:tbl = through back loop sts = stitches

tog = together st st = Stockinette stitch (k one row, p one row)

inc = increase yo = yarn over psso = pass slipped st over PM = place marker

M1R = Pick up bar between last st knit and next bringing needle from the back to the front, k

in front of the st.

M1L = Pick up bar between last st knit and next bringing needle from the front to the back, k

in back of the st.

Gauge: $5 \frac{1}{2}$ sts = 1" in st st

Rib Pattern: Row 1: *K 2 through back loop (tbl), P1; rep from * across.

Row 2: Work sts as they face you working P sts tbl on this row.

Right Mitt

With cc cast on 36 sts, knit 4 rows.

Change to mc and work in following pattern:

Row 1: K1tbl, *K9, yo, K1, yo, K3, sl 1, K2tog, psso, PM, P1* rep from * to * once, K1tbl.

Row 2: K1tbl, K1, P16, K1, P16, K1tbl..

Row 3: K1tbl, *K10, yo, K1, yo, K2, sl 1, K2tog, psso, P1* rep from * to * once, K1tbl.

Row 4, 6, 8, 10: rep Row 2.

Row 5: K1tbl, *K3tog, K4, yo, K1, yo, K3, yo, K1, yo, K1, K3tog, P1* rep from * to * once, K1tbl.

Row 7: K1tbl, *K3tog, K3, yo, K1, yo, K9, P1*, rep from * to * once, K1tbl.

Row 9: K1tbl, *K3tog, K2, yo, K1, yo, K10, P1*, rep from * to * once, K1tbl.

Row 11: K1tbl, *K3tog, K1, yo, K1, yo, K3, yo, K1, yo, K4, sl 1, K2tog, psso, P1*, rep from * to * once, K1tbl.

Row 12: Rep Row 2.

With cc K 4 rows.

With mc work rows 1-12.

With cc K 2 rows.

Thumb gusset:

Row 1: With mc work in ribbing pattern for 24 sts, PM, P1, M1L, K1, M1R, Pl, PM (gusset sts between markers), rib 9 sts to end. Gusset sts will be worked in garter st (knit every row) with a purl st on each side on right side.

Row 2: Work rib pattern to marker, sl marker, K gusset sts, sl marker, rib to end.

Continue in this manner on right side rows, increasing 1 st each side of gusset as follows until there are 15 sts between markers: Working rib to marker, sl marker, P1, M1R, K to just before P st, M1L, P1, sl marker, rib to end.

Next Row: Work to marker, remove marker, place gusset sts on holder or waste yarn, rib to end. (33 sts on needles)

Change to cc and work ribbing for 4 rows. Bind off loosely in pattern.

Attach cc to gusset sts and work 4 rows in ribbing. Bind off loosely in pattern.

Sew seam for thumb. Sew palm seam. Weave in all ends.

Left Mitt:

Work as for Right Mitt until thumb gusset. Work set up gusset row as follows:

With mc work in ribbing pattern for 9sts, PM, P1, M1L, K1, M1R, Pl, PM (gusset sts between markers), rib 24 sts to end.

Complete in same manner as Right Mitt.
