Eco Alpaca Cabled Wristers

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Materials:

1 Hank Cascade Yarns *Eco Alpaca* (3.5oz/100g ea approx. 220yds/200m, 100% undyed baby alpaca) #1517 Size 5 DPNs

Tapestry Needle

Cable Needle

Gauge:

22 sts and 31 rows over 4" in Stockinette

Approximate Finished Size:

One Size Fits All Adult Female 8" Circumference

Abbreviations:

KFB: knit through front and back

CN: cable needle

C3 Over 3 Right: sl 3 sts to cn, hold to back, k3, then k3 from cn C3 Over 3 Left: sl 3 sts to cn, hold to front, k3, then k3 from cn

M1: make 1

PM: place marker SLM: slip marker

<u>Instructions:</u>

Left Wrister

With DPNs, CO 40 sts, join into round

Work *k2, p2* rib for 3"

Next Round: *k2,p2* to last st, kfb – 41 sts

Next Round: k20, pm, m1, k1, m1, pm, k5, work row 1 of chart across next 15 sts

Knit 2 rounds

Next Round: knit to marker, slm, m1, k3, m1, slm, k5, work chart across next 15 sts, knit to end of round Repeat last 3 rounds making 2 sts between markers as above on increase rounds until there are 15 gusset sts

Next Round: work across round, placing 15 gusset sts on scrap yarn, inc 1 st over gap, work to end of round – 41 sts

Work even until piece measures 7.5" from CO edge or until desired length is reached, ending chart on row 6

Next Round: k2tog, k1, p2, *k2, p2* to end of row – 40 sts

Work 3 rounds of *k2, p2* rib

BO in rib

Transfer 15 gusset sts to DPNs, picking up 1 st where thumb and body of mitt meet – 16 sts Work in *k2, p2* rib for 4 rounds

BO in rib Weave in all loose ends with tapestry needle Block

Right Wrister


Work cuff as for left wrister

Next Round: work chart across 15 sts, k5, pm, m1, k1, m1, pm, k20

Knit 2 rounds

Next Round: work chart across next 15 sts, k5, slm, m1, k3, m1, slm, k to end of round

Continue on to end as for left wrister
