# Pacific Matching Hat and Scarf

Materials Needed: 1-2 skeins of Pacific

Stitch Markers

US size 7 / 16" Circular Needle or size to obtain gauge

### **Gauge: 5 Sts/Inch** **Gauge Swatch**

With either 16" or 24" Needle - CO 26 Sts, K 3 Rows:

1: K3, P20, K3                      2: K all Sts

Continue 1 & 2 for approximately 3", then K 3 rows, slide off needle and measure.

Sometimes your knitting gauge will change when knitting in the round, so you may want to make your swatch in the round. CO around 56 Sts, join, and K for about 3" and count stitches.

### **Lacy Pattern (Multiples of 6)**

Round 1: \*YO, K1, SK2TP, K1, YO, K1\*

Round 2: \*K all stitches\*

Repeat Rounds two for 1.5" or desired width of collar

End with Round 2 and remove marker.

### **Scarf**

You can decide if you want a thin or wide scarf, just cast on multiples of 6, plus border Sts. I recommend you CO border Sts, place a marker, CO Sts for scarf divisible by 6, place a marker, and CO ending border Sts. Because you are knitting back and forth, the 2 row will be a purl row.

1. Border, \*YO, K1, SK2TP, K1 YO, K1\* to border Sts

1. Border, P all Sts, to border Sts,

Repeat these 2 rows for desired length of scarf and bind off loosely.

### **Hat**

**Small to Medium CO 90 Sts; Medium to large CO 96 Sts**

Join without twisting and place a marker.

Round 1: \*YO, K1, SK2TP, K1, YO, K1\*

Round 2: \*K all stitches\*

Repeat Rounds two approximately 9"

K 2 Together around

Finish Top of Hat - Cut 10-12" tail, thread tapestry needle, remove marker and slip Sts from knitting needle to tapestry needle, pull gently to close hole on top, place 2-3 Sts. Across top, turn inside out and do the same on inside, weave in end.
