## Pure Alpaca Moebius in Knits and Purls Designed for Linda Voss Plummer

2 skeins Purl Alpaca #3002  
Size 7 needles, or needles required to obtain gauge  
Darning needle  
Scrap yarn  
Crochet hook for provisional cast on

Gauge: 25 st/4" in pattern

This piece is knit lengthwise and then connected, inserting a Moebius twist, with Kitchener stitch. It can be made wider or more narrow by adding or subtracting stitches in units of 10. A narrow piece can be a neck accessory, wider will serve as a snood.

Using scrap yarn, cast on 75 sts. Change to main yarn and follow rows 1 and 2 of pattern until piece measures 36" or desired length. Do not bind off.  
Give one end half a twist and, using Kitchener st, join two ends.

Pattern:

Keeping in pattern, knit into back of the first st of every row and before last st, bring yarn to front and slip st purlwise.

Row 1: \*knit 5, purl 5\* repeat to last 5 sts, knit 5.

Row 2: \*knit 1, p 1\* repeat to last st, bring yarn to front and slip st purlwise. This makes a pleasing, elastic edge.

Wash and enjoy!
