# Eco Cloud

## 1-skein Neckwarmer

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#### Size

One size fits most.

#### **Finished Measurements**

Approximately 5¼ inches by 40 inches. (Pattern shown has 5 blocks by 44 blocks.)

#### Materials

\*1 skein Cascade Yarn's Eco Cloud #1808; fiber content: 70% undyed merino wool;

30% undyed baby alpaca

\*1 pair US 6 needles

\*1 yarn needle

\*2 oval buttons (narrow enough to slip through stitches)

\*Thread for sewing buttons

#### Gauge

Approximately 19 stitches and 22 rows per 4 inches in stitch pattern.

#### **Neck Warmer Block Stitch Pattern Instructions**

Cast on 25 stitches. Continue in block stitch, as follows.

Rows 1, 3, 5, 6, and 8: k5, \* p5, k5; rep fr \* across to end of row.

Rows 2, 4, 7, and 9: p5, \* k5, p5; rep fr \* across to end of row.

Row 10: k5, \* p5, k5. Repeat from \* across to end of row.

Continue in 10-row block stitch pattern until neck warmer measures 40 inches or desired

length. Bind off loosely.

#### Finishing

Sew buttons and weave in ends.

#### Notes

\*For a smooth edging, slip the first stitch of every row. If the last stitch of the previous row is knit, slip the first stitch of the next row as if to purl and vice versa.

\*Select buttons that are small enough to slip through the knitted stitches, eliminating the

need for creating buttonholes or loops, and adding styling versatility.
