



Cloud 9 Patrice Jacket

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A short jacket, bordered with I-cord, is the perfect accessory for every wardrobe. This one features 2/2 ribbed, set-in sleeves edged with garter stitch. The wide collar repeats the stitch and edging. A smart crochet flower, worked in contrasting yarn, sets it all off and acts as a closure. Skill Level

Intermediate

Size

Woman's small (medium, large, extra-large) Instructions are given for smallest size, with larger sizes in parentheses. When only 1 number is given, it applies to all sizes. Model shown in size small. Finished Measurements

Chest: 38 (42, 46, 50)"

Armhole depth: 7 1/2 (8, 8 1/2, 9)" Side to underarm: 6 (6, 6 1/2, 7)" Sleeve length: 18 (18, 18 1/2, 19)" Materials

- Cascade Yarns Cloud 9, 50% Merino wool/50% angora (50g/109 yds per ball): 8 (8, 9, 10) balls #110 white (MC)
- Cascade Yarns Invito, 50% cotton/50% nylon (50g/140 yds per ball): 1 ball #06 (CC)
- Size 6 (4mm) 29" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size G/6 crochet hook
- Size H/8 crochet hook
- Stitch holders
- Stitch markers
- 1 large snap set

Gauge

21 sts and 28 rows = 4" in St st

28 sts and 25 rows = 4" in 2/2 Rib

To save time, take time to check gauge.

Designer Notes

Circular needles are used to accommodate large number of sts. Do not join; work in rows.

Special Abbreviation

W&T (Wrap & Turn): Bring yarn to front of work, sl next st to RH needle purlwise, take yarn to back of work, replace st to LH needle, turn.

Pattern Stitch

2/2 Rib

Row 1 (RS): K2, *p2, k2; rep from * across row.

Row 2: P2, *k2, p2; rep from * across row. Rep Rows 1 – 2 for pat.

BODY

With MC, cast on 176 (196, 214, 232) sts. Purl 1 row.

Working in St st, inc 1 st each end every RS row 12 (12, 14, 16) times – 200 (220, 242, 264) sts.

Work even until body measures 6 (6, 61/,27)" from beg, ending with a WS row.

Divide for fronts and back

Place markers 50 (55, 61, 66) sts in from each end. These will be the fronts; you will have 100 (110, 120, 132) sts marked for the back.

Next row (RS):Knit to 9 (12, 15, 16) sts before first marker, sl sts just worked to holder for right front, bind off 18 (24, 30, 32) sts for right underarm, knit to 9 (12, 15, 16) sts before second marker, place rem sts on second holder.

BACK

Working on back sts only, dec 1 st each end every RS row 4 (5, 5, 6) times – 74 (76, 80, 88) sts.

Work even until armhole measures 7 1/2 (8, 8 1/2, 9)" above bound-off underarm sts, ending with a WS row.

Shape back neck and shoulders

Mark center 30 (32, 34, 38) sts.

Next row (RS): Knit to first marker, join second ball of yarn and bind off marked sts, knit to end of row.

Working on both sides of neck with separate balls of yarn, dec 1 st at each neck edge every row 3 times, at the same time bind off at each arm edge 6 (6, 7, 7) sts twice, then 7 (7, 6, 8) sts once.

LEFT FRONT

SI sts from second holder to LH needle. With RS facing join yarn at underarm. Bind off 18 (24, 30, 32) sts, knit to end of row. Dec 1 st at arm edge every RS row 4 (5, 5, 6) times -37 (38, 41, 44) sts. Work even until front measures 4 1/2 (5, 5, 5 1/2)" above bound-off underarm sts, ending with a RS row.

Shape neck

Next row (WS): Bind off 13 (14, 15, 16) sts, purl to end of row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge every RS row 5 (5, 6, 6) times – 19 (19, 20, 22) sts.

Work even until armhole measures same as for back above bound-off underarm sts.

Shape shoulders

Bind off at arm edge 6 (6, 7, 7) sts twice, then 7 (7, 6, 8) sts once.

RIGHT FRONT

SI sts from first holder to LH needle. With WS facing, join yarn at underarm. Purl 1 row. Dec 1 st at arm edge every RS row 4 (5, 5, 6) times – 37 (38, 41, 44) sts.

Work even until front measures $4 \frac{1}{2} (5, 5, 5 \frac{1}{2})$ " above bound-off underarm sts, ending with a WS row.

Shape neck

Next row (RS): Bind off 13 (14, 15, 16) sts, purl to end of row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge every RS row 5 (5, 6, 6) times – 19 (19, 20, 22) sts.

Work even until armhole measures same as for back above bound-off underarm sts.

Shape shoulders

Bind off at arm edge 6 (6, 7, 7) sts twice, then 7 (7, 6, 8) sts once.

SLEEVES

With MC, cast on 36 (44, 48, 52) sts. Knit 5 rows, inc 2 (2, 2, 6) sts evenly on last row -38 (46, 50, 58) sts. Working in 2/2 Rib, inc 1 st each end every 6th row 14 times, working added sts into pat -66 (74, 78, 86) sts Work even in established pat until sleeve measures 18 (18, 18 1/2, 19)" from beg, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap

Bind off 9 (12, 15, 16) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end every RS row 4 (5, 5, 6) times. Work even for 1 1/2 (1 3/4, 2, 2 1/4)"

above last dec.

Dec 1 st each end every RS row 3 (4, 3, 3) times, Bind off 4 (3, 3, 3) sts at beg of next 4 (4, 6, 4) rows, then 3 (4, 0, 4) sts at beg of next 2 (2,0, 2) rows.

Bind off rem 12 (12, 14, 16) sts.

I-CORD BORDER

Sew shoulder seams.

Beg at left neck edge, pick up 3 sts for every 4 rows along front edges, 1 st in every row along shaped lower edges, and 9 sts for every 10 sts of cast-on edge, end at right neck edge. Join yarn and cast on 4 sts next to first picked-up st.

*K3, ssk (cord st and picked-up body st), return sts back to LH needle. Rep from * until all picked-up sts have been worked. Bind off 4; do not cut yarn. Leave last st on RH needle.

COLLAR

With RS facing, pick up and knit 1 st in every st or row along entire neckline. Do not pick up sts in I-cord Border at left front edge. Adjust sts if necessary to have a multiple of 4 sts. Place marker at each shoulder seam.

Set up pat (RS): SI 1, k2, *p2, k2; rep from * to last st, k1. Slipping first st of every row, work 1 row in established rib. Shape back collar

Work established pat to second marker, W&T, work to next marker, W&T.

*Work to 2 sts beyond previous wrap, W&T; rep from * 3 times more.

Next row: Removing markers and working each wrap tog with its main st, work across all sts.

Work even in established rib until collar measures 3 1/2" when measured at front edge, ending with a RS row. Knit 4 rows, dec 1 st each end every RS row. Bind off loosely knitwise on WS.

FLOWER TRIM

With larger crochet hook and CC, leaving a 12" end, ch 30 sts very loosely. Change to smaller hook.

Work (hdc, dc, hdc, sl st) in each of first 6 ch; (4 dc in next ch, sl 1 in next ch) 6 times; (5 tr in next ch, sc in next ch) 6 times. Fasten off.

Cut yarn, leaving an 8" end.

Roll trim into rosette shape, having smaller 'petals' at center. Using longer end, stitch across back to hold petals in place.

ASSEMBLY

Sew sleeves into armholes. Sew sleeve seams. Sew snap to top corners of neck edge. Sew Flower Trim to right front of neck, using 8" end.
