### Cascade Rustic Shrug "SOLUTION" Sizes S/M, L/XL, XXL CYPW197

Shown in size Large/XL Skill Level: Intermediate

**MATERIALS**: 5/6/6 skeins Cascade Yarns *Rustic col.09* (100g/196yards), knitting needles size US9 (5,5 mm) for rib and US 10 (6mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE, cable needle, tapestry needle, stitch markers, yarn in a contrasting color for marking (you will just pull a piece of yarn through at indicated rows).

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Center of back to wrist: 31"/31"/32" Length from center of back: 26" /26"/27-3/4" Width: 42-1/2"/48"/52" **Note**: Due to the design of this garment, there is quite a bit of wrap in the front which will accommodate multiple sizes for each size given. The length given is for the back. The fronts will hang down lower.

**<u>GAUGE</u>**: 16sts/24 rows in needles size US 9 (6mm) over Stst =4"/4" Stockinette Stitch: Knit on right-side rows, purl on wrong-side rows TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE. IT IS ALSO BETTER TO KNIT A BIGGER GAUGE (=cast on more stitches) TO GET A MORE PRECISE MEASUREMENT.

**SEWING OFF STITCHES**: Break wool and leave a tail, about three times the length of width of the stitches you want to sew off. Thread through a blunt tapestry needle. You will work from right to left. \*Put tapestry needle through the first two stitches as if to purl, from right to left. Pull through. Put needle back through the first of the two stitches as if to knit, from left to right. Pull through. Slip the first stitch of the needle. Repeat from \* being careful not to pull the yarn too tight.

**<u>SSK</u>**: slip 2 sts knit wise, one at a time, then insert the tip of the left-hand needle into the fronts of these two stitches from the left, and then knit them together from this position.

<u>M1</u>: Pick up the strand between the stitches from the front with the left needle. Then knit into the back of it.




**<u>FINISHING</u>**: Block pieces.Close sleeve seams up to yarn marker A. Set in front piece with the center of backs together (D). Yarn marker A (sleeves)and yarn marker x from front go together.

**cn** = cable needle

**PM** = Place marker

## BACKWARD LOOP:



FRONTS S/M: Cast on 56 sts with smaller needle.

Row 1:\* p2, k4\*, repeat from \*to\*3 more times, p1, place marker, k12 (work from graph), place marker, p1,\* k4, p2\*, repeat from \*to\*2 more times

Row 2: \*k2, p4\*, repeat from \*to\*2 more times, k1,slip marker, p12 (from graph), slip marker, k1,\* p4, k2\*, repeat from \*to\* 2 more times, p4, slip last 2 sts as if to purl (you will **<u>always</u>** slip these last two stitches on the wrong-side rows)

Row 3: \*p2, put 2 sts on cable needle behind work, k2, k2 from cable needle\* repeat from \*to\* 3 more times, p1, slip marker, work next 12 sts from graph row 3,slip marker, p1, \*put 2 sts on a cable needle behind work, k2, k2 from cable needle, p2\* repeat from \*to\* 2 times more.

Row 4: as row 2

Change to bigger size needle.

Row 5: as row 1

Row 6: as row 2

Row 7: knit, continue with 12-stitch cable pattern from graph (row 7), repeat row 1-24 four times, then row 1-3 once. Always move the stitch markers as you go.

Row 8: purl (do not forget to slip the last two stitches purlwise)

Row 9 – 28: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 29: k4, ssk, knit to end = 55 sts

Row 30- 32: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 33: k4, ssk, knit to end = 54 sts

Row 34 – 38: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 39: k4, ssk, knit to end = 53 sts

Row 40 – 44: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 45: k4, ssk, knit to end = 52 sts

Row 46 – 50: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 51: k4, ssk, knit to end = 51 sts

Row 52 - 54: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 55: k4, ssk, knit to end = 50 sts

Row 56: Bind off 2 sts at the beginning of the row = 48 sts

Row 57: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 47 sts

Row 58: purl

Row 59: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 45 sts

Row 60: purl Row 61: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 44 sts Row 62: purl Row 63: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 42 sts Row 64: purl Row 65: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 41 sts Row 66: purl, also place varn marker x at the beginning of this row Row 67: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2 tog = 39 sts Row 68: purl Row 69: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 38 sts Row 70: purl Row 71: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 36 sts Row 72: purl Row 73: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 35 sts Row 74: purl Row 75: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 33 sts Row 76: purl Row 77: knit to last 2 sts, k2 tog = 32 sts Row 78: purl Row 79: k4, ssk, knit to last 2sts, k2tog = 30 sts Row 80 - 84: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 85: k4, ssk, knit to end = 29 sts Row 86 – 90: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 91: k4, ssk, knit to end = 28 sts Row 92 – 96: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 97: k4, ssk, knit to end = 27 sts Row 98 - 100 continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 99: is also the last row of cable pattern Row 101: k4, ssk, knit to end = 26 sts Row 102 – 104: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 105: k4, ssk, knit to end = 25 sts Row 106 – 108: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 109: k4, ssk, knit to end = 24 sts Row 110 - 138: continue in Stockinette Stitch. Row 139: Place a yarn marker D at the end of this row. This will mark the center of the back. Row 140 – 168: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 169: k4, M1, knit to end = 25 sts Row 170 - 172: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 173: k4, M1, knit to end = 26 sts Row 174 - 176: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 177: k4, M1, knit to end = 27 sts Row 178: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 179: begin of cable pattern, k10, PM, 12 sts from graph, PM (row 15-18 once, row 1-24 four times), k5 Row 180: purl Row 181: k4, M1, knit to end = 28 sts Row 182-186: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 187: k4, M1, knit to end = 29 sts Row 188 – 192: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 193: k4, M1, knit to end = 30 sts Row 194 – 198: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 199: k4, M1, knit to end, at the end of the row increase 1 st by making a backward loop = 32 sts (=loop 1 st) Row 200: purl Row 201: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 33 sts

Row 202: purl Row 203: k4, M1, knit to end, loop 1 st = 35 sts Row 204: purl Row 205: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 36 sts Row 206: purl Row 207: k4, M1, knit to the end, loop 1 st = 38 sts Row 208: purl Row 209: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 39 sts Row 210: purl Row 211: k4, M1, knit to the end, loop 1 st = 41 Row 212: purl, place varn marker x at the beg of this row. Row 213: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 42 sts Row 214: purl Row 215: k4, M1, knit to the end, loop 1 st = 44 sts Row 216: purl Row 217: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 45 sts Row 218: purl Row 219: k4, M1, knit to the end, loop 1 st = 47 sts Row 220: purl Row 221: knit to the end, loop 1 sts = 48 sts Row 222: purl Row 223: k4, M1, knit to the end, loop 2 sts = 51 sts Row 224: purl Row 225 – 226: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 227: k4, M1, knit to the end = 52stsRow 228 – 232: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 233: k4, M1, finish row = 53 sts Row 234 – 238: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 239: k4, M1, finish row = 54 sts Row 240 – 244: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 245: k4, M1, finish row = 55 sts Row 246 – 248: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 249: k4, M1, finish row = 56 sts Row 250 – 271: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 272: \*k2p4\* repeat from \*to\* 2 times more, k1, p12 (from graph), k1, \*p4k2\* repeat from \*to\* 2 times more, p4, slip the last 2 sts purlwise. Row 273: \*p2, k4\* repeat from \*to\*3 times more, p1, k12, p1, \*k4, p2\* repeat from \*to\* 2 times more Row 274: change to smaller size needles: as row 272 Row 275:\* p2, put 2 sts on cable needle and hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle \* repeat from \*to\* 2times more, p1, k 12 sts from graph, p1 \*put 2 sts on a cable needle, hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle, p2\*. Repeat from \*to\* 3more times, but slip last 2 sts purlwise. Row 276: as row 272 Row 277: as row 273 Sew off stitches as described. SLEEVES AND BACK SIZE S/M : with smaller needle cast on 42 sts. Row 1: p1\*k4p2\*repeat from \*to\*end with p1 Row 2: k1\*p4k2\*repeat from \*to\* end with k1 Row 3: p1 \*put 2sts on a cable needle behind work, k2, knit 2 sts from cable needle p2\* repeat from \*to\* end with p1 Row4: as row 2 Row 5: as row 1 Row 6: as row 2 Repeat Row 1-6: 5 more times = 36 rows have been worked from beginning.

Continue with bigger size needle in Stockinette Stitch.

Row 37: knit on odd rows

Row 38: purl on even rows Row 39 – 50: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 51: k3, M1, knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 44 sts Row 52 – 56: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 57: k3, M1, knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 46 sts Row 58 - 62: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 63: k3, M1, knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 48 sts Row 64 – 68: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 69: k3, M1, knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 50 sts Row 70 – 74: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 75: k3, M1, knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 52 sts Row 76 - 78: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 79: knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 53 sts Row 80 : purl Row 81: k3, M1, finish row = 54 sts Row 82 - 84: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 85: knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 55 sts Row 86 : purl Row 87: k3, M1, knit to end = 56 sts Row 88: purl Row 89: k3, M1 knit to end = 57 sts Row 90: purl Row 91: knit to last 3 sts M1 = 58 sts Row 92: purl Row 93: k3, M1, knit to end = 59sts Row 94 - 96: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 97: knit to last 3 sts, M1, knit to end = 60 sts Row 98: purl Row 99: k3, M1, knit to end = 61sts Row 100: purl Row 101: k3, M1, knit to end = 62 sts Row 102: purl Row 103: knit to last 3 sts, M1, knit to end = 63 sts Row 104 – 106: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 107: k3, M1, knit to last 3 sts, M1, knit to end = 65 sts Row 108 – 110: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 111: k3, M1, knit to last 3 sts, M1, knit to end = 67 sts. Also place a yarn marker A at the beg and end of this row (this means you close the sleeve seem from the cabled rib beg up to this marker) Row 112: purl Row 113: knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 68 sts Row 114: purl Row 115: knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 69stsRow 116: purl Row 117: knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 70 sts Row 118: purl Row 119: knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 71 sts Row 120: purl Row 121: knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3 = 72 sts Row 122: purl Row 123: knit to last 3 sts, M1, k3. = 73 sts. Place a yarn marker B at the end of this row (this will be the end of picked up stitches of the bottom for ribbing) Row 124 – 185: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 186: Place a varn marker D at the end of this purl row. It will be the marker for the center of the back. Row 187 – 249: Continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 250: at the beginning of the this row place a yarn marker B. This will be the beginning where you will pick up stitches from the bottom for ribbing. Row 251: knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 72 sts Row 252: purl Row 253: knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 71 sts Row 254: purl Row 255: knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 70sts Row 256: purl Row 257: knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 69 sts Row 258: purl Row 259: knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 68 sts Row 260: purl Row 261: knit to last 4 sts, ssk,  $k^2 = 67$  sts Row 262: purl, place a yarn marker A at the beginning and end of this row. This will be where the sleeve seam ends. Row 263: k2, k2 tog, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 65 sts Row 264- 266: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 267: k2, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 63 sts Row 268 – 270: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 271: knit to last 4 sts, ssk,  $k^2 = 62$  sts Row 272: purl Row 273: k2, k2 tog = 61 sts Row 274: purl Row 275: k2, k2tog, knit to end = 60 sts Row 276: purl Row 277: knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 59 sts Row 278 - 280: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 281: k2, k2tog = 58sts Row 282: purl Row 283: knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 57 sts Row 284: purl Row 285: k2, k2 tog, knit to end = 56 sts Row 286: purl Row 287: k2, k2 tog, knit to end = 55 sts Row 288: purl Row 289: knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 54 sts Row 290 – 292: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 293: k2, k2 tog, knit to end = 53 sts Row 294: purl Row 295: knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 52 sts Row 296 – 298: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 299: k2, k2 tog, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 50 sts Row 300 – 304: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 305: k2, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 48 sts Row 306 – 310: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 311: k2, k2 tog, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 46 sts Row 312- 316: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 317: k2, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 44 sts Row 318 - 322: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 323: k2, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 = 42 sts Row 324 – 335: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 336: k1\*p4k2\* repeat from \*to\* end with k1 Row 337: p1 \*k4p2\* repeat from \*to\* end with p1 Row 338: k1 \*p4k2\* repeat from \*to\* end with k1 Row 339: p1 \*put 2 sts on a cable needle, hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle, p2\* repeat from \*to\*

end with p1 Row 340: as row 336 Row 341: as row 337 Repeat Rows 336-341 five times more: you have worked all together 36 rows in the cable rib pattern. Sew off stitches as described.

<u>ADDING THE BOTTOM RIBBING</u>: Looking at the right-side of finished piece, along the left side where you placed yarn markers B with smaller needles pick up 104 sts from marker B to marker B.

Row 1:\* k2p4\* repeat from \*to\* ending with k2 Row 2: \*p2k4\* repeat from \*to\* ending with p2 Row 3: As row 1 Row 4: As row 2 Row 5: As row 1 Row 6: \*p2, put 2 sts on cable needle and hold to back, k2, k2 from cable needle\* repeat from \*to\* ending with p2. Repeat row 1 -6: 7 more times. Repeat row 1, 2 and 3. 51 rows have been knitted. Sew off stitches.

FRONTS L/XL: Cast on 62 sts with smaller needle.

Row 1: k6, p2, k4, p2, k4, p2, k4, p1, place marker, k12 (work these 12 stitches from graph), place marker, p1, k4, p2, k4, p2, k4, p2, k4, p2

Row 2: k2, p4, k2, p4, k2, p4, k2, p4, k1, slip marker, p12, slip marker, k1, p4, k2, p4, k2, p4, k2, p4 slip last 2 sts as if to purl (you will <u>always</u> slip these last two stitches on the wrong-side rows) Row 3: k2 \*put 2 sts on cable needle behind work, k2, k2 from cable needle, p2\* repeat 3 times but only p1 for the last repeat instead of p2, next 12 sts from graph row 3, p1, \*put 2 sts on a cable needle be-

hind work, k2, k2 from cable needle, p2\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times more.

Row 4: as row 2

Change to bigger size needle.

Row 5: as row 1

Row 6: as row 2

Row 7: knit, continue with 12-stitch cable pattern from graph. Repeat row 1-24 four times, then row 1-3 once. Always move the stitch markers as you go.

Row 8: purl (do not forget to slip the last two stitches purlwise)

Row 9 - 26: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 27: k4, ssk, knit to end = 61 sts

Row 28 - 30: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 31: k4, ssk, knit to end = 60 sts

Row 32 – 34: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 35: k4, ssk, knit to end = 59 sts

Row 36 – 38: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 39: k4, ssk, knit to end = 58 sts

Row 40 – 46: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 47: k4, ssk, knit to end = 57 sts

Row 48 - 49: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern

Row 50: Bind off 2 sts at the beginning of the row = 55 sts

Row 51: knit

Row 52: Bind off 2 sts at the beginning of the purl row = 53 sts

Row 53: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 51 sts

Row 54: purl

Row 55: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 50 sts

Row 56: purl

Row 57: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 48 sts

Row 58: purl Row 59: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 47 sts Row 60: purl Row 61: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 45 sts, also place yarn marker x at the end of this row. Row 62: purl Row 63: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 44 sts Row 64: purl Row 65: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2 tog = 42 sts Row 66: purl Row 67: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 41 sts Row 68: purl Row 69: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 39 sts Row 70: purl Row 71: knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 38 sts Row 72: purl Row 73: k4, ssk, knit to the last 2 sts, k2tog = 36 sts Row 74 – 78: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 79: k4, ssk, knit to last 2 sts, k2 tog = 34 sts Row 80 – 84: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 85: k4, ssk, knit to end = 33 sts Row 86 – 90: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 91: k4, ssk, knit to end = 32 sts Row 92 – 96: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 97: k4, ssk, knit to end = 31 sts Row 98 - 102: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 99: is also the last row of cable pattern Row 103: k4, ssk, knit to end = 30 sts Row 104 - 108: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 109: k4, ssk, knit to end = 29 sts Row 110 – 114: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 115: k4, ssk, knit to end = 28 sts Row 116 - 142: continue in Stockinette Stitch. Row 143 – 170: Place a varn marker D at the end of row 143. This will mark the center of the back. Continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern. Row 171: k4, M1, knit to end = 29 sts Row 172 - 176: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 177: k4, M1, knit to end = 30 sts Row 178 - 182: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 183: k4, M1, knit to end = 31 sts Row 184 – 186: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 187: begin of cable pattern, k10, PM, 12 sts from graph (row 15-18 once, then row 1-24 four times), k9 Row 188: purl Row 189: k4, M1, knit to end = 32 sts Row 190 – 194: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 195: k4, M1, knit to end = 33 sts Row 196 – 200: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 201: k4, M1, knit to end = 34 sts Row 202 – 206: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 207: k4, M1, knit to end, at the end of the row increase 1 st by making a backward loop = 36 sts (=loop 1 st) Row 208 – 212: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 213: k4, M1, knit to end, loop 1 st = 38 sts Row 214: purl Row 215: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 39 sts

Row 216: purl Row 217: k4, M1, knit to end, loop 1 st = 41 sts Row 218: purl Row 219: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 42 sts Row 220: purl Row 221: k4, M1, knit to the end, loop 1 st = 44 sts Row 222: purl Row 223: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 45 sts Row 224: purl Row 225: k4, M1, knit to the end, loop 1 st = 47 sts, place yarn marker x at the end of this row. Row 226: purl Row 227: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 48 sts Row 228: purl Row 229: k4, M1, knit to the end, loop 1 st = 50 sts Row 230: purl Row 231: knit to the end, loop 1 st = 51 sts Row 232: purl Row 233: k4, M1, knit to the end, loop 1 st = 53 sts Row 234: purl Row 235: knit to the end, loop 2 sts = 55 sts Row 236: purl Row 237: knit to the end, loop 2 sts = 57 sts Row 238: purl Row 239: k4, M1, knit to the end = 58 sts Row 240 – 246: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 247: k4, M1, finish row = 59 sts Row 248 – 250: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 251: k4, M1, finish row = 60 sts Row 252 – 254: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 255: k4. M1. finish row = 61 sts Row 256 – 258: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 259: k4, M1, finish row = 62 sts Row 260 – 279: continue in Stockinette Stitch pattern Row 280: \*k2, p4\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times more, k1, p12, k1, \*p4k2\* repeat from \*to\* 2 times more, p4, slip the last 2 sts purlwise. Row 281: k6, \*p2, k4\* repeat from \*to\*2 times more, p1, k12, p1, \*k4, p2\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times more . Row 282: change to smaller size needles: \*k2, p4\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times more, k1, p12, k1, \*p4k2\* repeat from \*to\* 2 times more, p4, slip the last 2 sts purlwise Row 283: k2 \*put 2 sts on cable needle and hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle, p2\* repeat from \*to\* 3 times more but the last repeat will end with p1 instead of p2. Next 12 sts from graph. P1 \*put 2 sts on a cable needle, hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle, p2\*. Repeat from \*to\* 3 more times. Row 284: as row 280 Row 285: as row 281 Sew off stitches as described. SLEEVES AND BACK SIZE L/XL : with smaller needle cast on 46 sts.






ABOVE = S/M FRONT CHART




ABOVE = S/M BACK AND SLEEVE CHART




ABOVE = L/XL FRONT CHART
