Cascade Magnum Vest

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Cascade Yarns Magnum 2 hanks
#17 & #19 needles

Sizes: 36" & 42"
4 Stitch Holders

Gauge on # 19 needles 1 1/2 sts. = 1 "

Back:

Using #17 needles cast on 28 / 32 sts. and begin rib with K1, (P2, K2) rep. ending with K1. For the next 6 rows, work stitches as they are. Change to #19 needles and beginning with a knit row, work 19 more rows. Shape armholes as follows: bind off 1 stitch at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 st. at the beginning and the end of the next row and continue for 13 more rows. Knit 8 / 9 sts. Place center 8 / 10 sts. on a holder. turn and P2tog, Purl to end of row. Work 2 rows more and place stitches on a holder. Rejoin yarn and work the other shoulder as before and place on holder.

Front:

Work as for back to 11 rows above armhole shaping. Shape neck by working 9 / 10 sts. and placing the center 6 / 8 sts. on a holder. Turn and decrease 1 st. at neck edge on the next 2 rows. Work to same length as back and knit this shoulder together with the back.

Rejoin yarn and work other shoulder to match. Do not knit this shoulder together yet.

With #17 needles pick up and knit 36 / 40 sts. from neck edge and work rib pattern for 8 rows and bind off loosely. Knit the remaining shoulder together and sew collar and side seams.
