Kid Seta Noir Lace Pullover

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Original garment shown in a size 36" (92cm)

MATERIALS: Kid Seta Noir 12 (14; 16) balls (Needs to be double stranded)

One pair each US 5 (3.75mm) and US 6 (4mm) knitting needles.

One stitch holder.

MEASUREMENTS:

To fit bust: 36 (38;40) inches

Actual all round measurement of garment: Bust: 39 (41; 43) inches

Length to shoulder: 23 (24; 25) inches

Sleeve seam: 16(17; 18) inches

The instructions are given for the smallest size, with the larger sizes in brackets. Where only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

GAUGE: 26 sts and 26 rows = 4 inch (10cm) over Lace Pattern using US 6 (4mm) needles and 2 strands of yarn together.

For best results it is essential to obtain the correct gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt = alternate; beg = begin(ning); cont = continue; dec = decrease; foll(s) = follow(s)ing; k = knit; patt(s) =
pattern(s); p = purl; rem = remain; rep = repeat; rev = reverse; R(W)SF = right(wrong) side facing; R(W)SR =
right(wrong) side row; RW = ribwise; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; yfd = yarn forward.

STITCHES USED:

LACE PATTERN:

1st **row:** K1, k2tog, k4, yfd, k1, yfd, *k4, k3tog, k4, yfd, k1, yfd, rep from * to last 7sts, k4, k2tog, k1.

2nd row: P.

Rep these 2 rows.

DOUBLE RIB PATTERN:

1st row: *K2, p2, rep from * to end.

2nd row: *P2, k2, rep from * to end.

Rep these 2 rows.

BACK:

Using US 6 (4mm) needles and 2 strands of yarn tog, cast on 123 (135; 147)sts and cont straight in Lace Patt (SEE STS USED) and when work measures 15 (16; 16) inches from beg ending with a WSR,

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Cast off 6 (6; 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2sts at beg of foll 6 (6; 8) rows, then dec 1 st (= work 2tog) at each end of every foll alt row 1 (5; 5) times = 97 (101; 107)sts. Cont straight and when work measures 23 (24; 25) inches from beg ending with a WSR,

SHAPE SHOULDERS: Cast off 8 (9; 10)sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 9 sts at beg of foll 2 rows = 47 (47; 49) sts. Cast off rem sts for back neck opening.

FRONT:

Work as for back and when work measures 20 (21; 22) inches from beg ending with a WSR.

SHAPE NECK: Patt 37 (39; 41)sts and leave these sts on a holder, cast off center 23 (23; 25)sts for neck opening and cont on rem sts for left side of work.

LEFT SIDE: Work one row. Cast off 2 sts at beg (neck edge) of next and every foll alt row 5 (5; 6) times in all, then 1 st at same edge of foll 2 alt rows = 25 (27; 27)sts. Cont straight and when work measures same as back to shoulder ending with a RSR.

SHAPE SHOULDER as for one side of back.

RIGHT SIDE: WSF, rejoin yarn at neck edge, pick up sts from holder and work as for left side, rev shapings.

SLEEVES (BOTH ALIKE):

Using US 6 (4mm) needles and 2 strands of yarn tog, cast on 111 (123; 123)sts and cont straight in Lace Patt and when work measures 16 (17; 18) inches from beg ending with a WSR

SHAPE TOP OF SLEEVE: Cast off 6sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2sts at beg of foll 14 (20; 18) rows, dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row 7 (4; 6) times in all, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 4 (6; 4) rows, 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 9 sts at beg of foll 2 rows = 19 (19; 25)sts. Cast off rem sts.

TO MAKE UP:

Sew right shoulder seam.

NECKBAND: RSF, using US 5 (3.75mm) needles and 2 strands tog, pick up and k 70 (78; 80)sts around neck opening of front and 48 (48; 50)sts across back neck = 118 (126; 130)sts. Work in Double Rib Patt (SEE STS USED) for 3cm ending with a WSR, cast off all sts RW. Sew left shoulder seam and neckband ends. Set in sleeves, sew up side and sleeve seams. Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
