Striped Tunic



SIERRA STRIPED TUNIC

MATERIALS: TENSION:

SIERRA = 9 SKS. MAIN COLOR of #27 5 STS. = 1" ON #7 NEEDLE
2 SKS. CONTRAST COLOR of #10
NEEDLES #5 & #7

BACK:

USING #5 NEEDLES AND MAIN COLOR (MC) CAST ON 110 STS. AND KNIT 6 ROWS.

CHANGE TO #7 NEEDLE AND CONTINUE AS FOLLOWS:

ROW 1. KNIT

ROW 2. K3, P104, K3.

REPEAT THESE ROWS FOR 4". CONTINUE IN ST. ST.

FROM NOW ON (KNIT 1 ROW, PURL 1 ROW) BUT REMEMBER TO DECREASE 1 ST. AT EACH OUTSIDE EDGE EVERY 3" 3 TIMES (104 STS. REMAIN).

WHEN PIECE MEASURES 18" DECREASE 1 ST. AT EACH EDGE FOR 10 ROWS. (94 STS.) AT THE SAME TIME: AT 19" KNIT 2 ROWS WITH CONTRAST COLOR (CC)

WORK MC FOR 6 ST.ST ROWS AND CC FOR 2 KNIT ROWS. WHEN YOU HAVE 7 STRIPES, WORK 4 MORE ROWS IN MC, THEN WORK ON 28 STS. ONLY FOR SHOULDER AND CONTINUE WITH 2 MORE ROWS MC, 2 ROWS CC, 4 ROWS MC AND BIND OFF. PUT CENTER 38 STS. ON HOLD FOR NECK LATER AND FINISH OTHER SHOULDER AS YOU JUST DID.

FRONT:

WORK AS FOR BACK UNTIL YOU HAVE COMPLETED 4 STRIPES. PLACE CENTER 24 STS. ON HOLD FOR LATER AND WORK EACH SHOULDER SEPARATELY.

CONTINUE IN STRIPE PATTERN AND AT THE SAME TIME BIND OFF 2 STS. AT NECK EDGE 1 TIME, AND 1 ST. 3 TIMES. CONTINUE UNTIL FRONT IS THE SAME LENGTH AS THE BACK AND BIND OFF.

SLEEVES: MAKE 2

WITH #5 NEEDLE AND MC, CAST ON 44 STS AND KNIT 6 ROWS. CHANGE TO #7 NEEDLE AND WORK 6 ROW IN ST.ST.

THEN KNIT 2 ROWS IN CC. CONTINUE IN STRIPE PATTERN AND INCREASE 1 ST.

EACH EDGE EVERY 4TH ROW TO 90 STS. AT 16" DECREASE 1 ST. AT EACH EDGE EVERY ROW 5 TIMES (80 STS) THEN 1 ST. EACH EDGE EVERY OTHER ROW 10 TIMES (60 STS) THEN BIND OFF 5 STS.

AT THE BEGINNING OF THE NEXT 10 ROWS. BIND OFF REMAINING 10 STS.

FINISHING:

SEW SHOULDER SEAMS TOGETHER AND SET IN THE SLEEVES AND SEW SIDE SEAMS REMEMBERING TO LEAVE THE SIDE VENTS OPEN. USING #5 NEEDLE. PICK UP AND KNIT 38 STS FROM BACK HOLDER, 15 STS TO CENTER FRONT, 28 STS IN CENTER FRONT, 15 STS TO BACK NECK. KNIT 1 ROUND, PURL 1 ROUND FOR 2 ¾" AND BIND OFF LOOSELY.
