# SOFT SPUNMOCK TURTLE PULLOVER Original Design Inspired by Wendy Bernard

Model Version rewritten by Susie Bonell for Bottom Up construction

MATERIALS: Cascade Yarn's Soft Spun 4 (5, 6, 7, 7) skeins # 2831
Needles size 8 and 9; +16" circular size 8
Yarn Needle
GAUGE: 16 st and 20 rows = 4" in st st

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS: 36" (39", 43", 47", 50")

### BACK

With size 9 needle, cast on 72 (76, 88, 96, 100) sts. Work in K2 P2 ribbing for 7". Change to Stockinette stitch (stst) and work until back measures 14" (14", 15", 15", 16") or desired length to underarm.

### **RAGLAN SHAPING**

Bind off 4 (8, 8, 8, 8,) sts at the beginning of next 2 rows. Begin decrease rows as follows: Raglan Decrease Row: (right side) K1, K 2 tog, K to last 3 sts, SSK, K1. Dec 1 st each side every 2nd row 13 (16, 10, 17, 16) times. Dec 1 st each side every 4th row 5 (0, 8, 5, 7) times.

Bind off remaining sts.

### FRONT

Work as for back including all shaping AT THE SAME TIME when piece measures  $20 \frac{1}{2}$ " (21", 22  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 22", 23"), work to center 16 (18, 20, 16, 14) sts. Attach another ball and bind off center 16 (18, 20, 16, 14) sts. Work both sides at once.

Bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 1 (1, 1, 2, 3) times. Dec 1 st at each neck edge every other row 4 (4, 5, 5, 6) times.

Continue shaping as for back End off.

### **SLEEVES**

Entire sleeve is worked in K2 P2 ribbing. Add sts into pattern as increases are made. With size 9 needles, cast on 44 (48, 52, 56, 56) sts. Inc 1 st each side every 8 (8, 6, 8, 4) rows 9 (9, 1, 11, 1) time, then every 10 (10, 8, 0, 6) row 1 (1, 10, 0, 14) times. Continue in pattern until sleeve measures 17" (17", 18", 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ ") or desired length to armhole.

## **CAP SHAPING**

Bind off 4 (8, 8, 8, 8) sts at beg of next 2 rows. On next right side row, dec 1 st each side by working two sts together, then dec 1 st each side every row, (2<sup>nd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>) row 15 (20, 24, 26, 30) times. Dec 1 st each side every 3<sup>rd</sup> (4<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 0) rows 10 (2, 1, 1, 0) times

Bind off remaining sts.

Sew shoulder seams together.

With size 8 circular needles, pick up and knit 68, (88, 96, 100, 116) evenly around neck. Working in rounds, work K2 P2 ribbing. Try to match ribbing pattern at sleeve top. Work ribbing for 3" and bind off loosely in pattern.

Sew side seams and weave in all ends. Steam slightly if needed.
