## Cascade Eco Duo Magic Rib Sweater

## ECO DUO MAGIC RIB SWEATER

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Materials: Cascade Yarn's Eco Duo: 6, 7 skeins for sweater #1701

Needles size 9 for sweater

Yarn needle

Gauge: 4 sts = 1", 6 rows = 1"

Finished Measurements: Due to the stretchiness of the rib pattern, several sizes are included in each size and are approximate. 32" – 40", 38" – 46"

Rib Pattern Stitch (every row is the same)

Row 1: (and all rows) K4, P1, \*K3, P1\* repeat between \*'s across row, end with K2.

Repeat Row 1 throughout.

#### SWEATER

Front and back are made the same.

Cast on 83, 95 sts. Work in rib pattern until piece measures 15" or desired length to underarm.

Bind off 8 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows (all sizes). Continue in pattern until armhole measures 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Bind off all stitches in pattern.

Repeat for other side.

#### SLEEVES

Cast on 63, 71 stitches. Work in rib pattern increasing 1 st each side every 4th row keeping continuity of pattern until there are 87, 95 sts. Continue working until sleeve measures 9", 10" or desired length to armhole. Bind off in pattern.

Sew shoulder seams leaving 10" opening for neck. Sew in sleeves.

Sew side seams. Weave in all ends.
