# LUNA LACE SAMPLER SWEATER

Designed by Susie Bonell

Materials: Cascade Yarns Luna Peruvian cotton: color A #9833 Paint 2 ( 2, 3, 4 ) skeins,  
Color B #743 peach 4 ( 4, 5, 6 ) skeins, color C #721 lt gold 4(4, 6, 7 ) skeins  
Needles sizes 6 & 7  
Markers  
Yarn needle

Gauge: 4.5 sts = 1", 7 rows = 1" in Stockinette st (st st)

Measurements: 35" (40", 45", 50"); length 20 (20,20,23) inches approx.

SKP = Sl 1, K1, pass slipped st over knit stitch.

Stockinette stitch = st st

## Lace Pattern Mult 12 + 1

Row 1: P1, \*SKP, K3, YO, K1, YO, K3, K2tog, P1\* rep from \* across.

Row 2: And all even rows, work sts as they appear, purl YO loops.

Row 3: P1, \*SKP, K2, YO, K3, YO, K2, K2tog, P1\* rep from \* across.

Row 5: P1 \*SKP, K1, YO, K5, YO, K1, K2tog, P1\* rep from \* across.

Row 7: P1, \*YO, K3, K2 tog, K1, SKP, K3, YO, P1\* Note: be sure to wrap yarn around needle  
again before

last P.

Row 9: P1, \*K1, YO, K2, K2tog, K1, SKP, K2, YO, K1, P1\* rep from \* across.

Row 11: P1, \*K2, YO, K1, K2tog, K1, SKP, K1, YO, K2, P1\* rep from \* across.

Row 12: Repeat row 2.

Repeat rows 1-12 once more for pattern section (24 rows)

## Lattice Pattern

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3, 7, 11, 15, 19, 23: K2, \*YO, sl 1, K2, pass slipped st over two knit stitches and drop.  
(pssso); rep from

\* across, end K1.

Row 4: And all even rows, Purl.

Row 5, 9, 13, 17, 21, 24: K1, \*sl 1, K2, pssso, YO, rep from \* end K2.

These 24 rows make up one section.

## FRONT and BACK are made alike

With size 6 needles and color C, cast on 78 (90, 102, 115) sts and work in K1, P1 ribbing for 2".

Change to size

7 needles and set up patterns as follows:

\*Section 1: With color A, work 49 (49, 61, 61) sts in row 1 of Lace Pattern, with color C, knit 5 sts (st st), with color B work 24 (36, 36, 49) sts in Lattice Pattern. Work until 24 rows have been completed in this section.

With color C work 6 rows in st st.

Section 2: With color B, work 24 (36, 36, 49) sts in Lattice Pattern, with color C 5 sts in st st, with color A, work 49 (49, 61, 61) sts in row 1 of Lace Pattern. Work until 24 rows have been completed in this section.

With color C work 6 rows in st st.

Repeat from \* once more. For largest size, repeat section 1 again to lengthen.

Change to size 6 needles and work in K1, P1 ribbing for 6 rows and bind off in ribbing.

Weave in ends and sew shoulder seams leaving center 10" ( 10", 11", 11") or desired width open for neck.

Place marker on sides (front and back) 10" (10", 11", 11") down for shoulder to indicate sleeve opening.

### SLEEVES

With color B and size 7 needles, pick up and knit 93 (93, 99, 99) sts evenly between sleeve markers. Purl one row.

Begin with row 3 of Lattice Pattern and work through the 24 rows.

With color C, work 6 rows of st st reducing 12 (12, 7, 7) sts to 81 (81, 92, 92) sts on 1<sup>st</sup> row and 8 (8, 7, 7) sts to 73 (73, 85, 85) sts on last row.

With color A work 24 rows of Lace Pattern.

ON FIRST TWO SIZES: change to size 6 needles and reduce sts to 60 on 1<sup>st</sup> row of 6 rows of K1, P1 ribbing. Bind off in ribbing.

ON SECOND TWO SIZES: change to color C, work 6 rows of st st reducing 7 sts to 78 sts on the 1<sup>st</sup> row and 8 sts on the last row.

Change to size 6 needles and reduce sts to 70 on 1<sup>st</sup> row of 6 rows of K1, P1 ribbing. Bind off in ribbing.

Weave in ends and sew underarm seams.
